Course Description	<p>The emphasis is placed on practical activities to develop the bricklaying skills of the students. The training starts with structured theory lessons, followed by hands on skills activities and the completion of assignments at the end of each module of work. Students will use and experience a variety of common bricklaying tools, plant and equipment. During the course, they will complete a number of practical projects including the use of bricklaying tools and materials, the building of simple structures and basic concreting. Students will find out about the long history of the craft and how demand for brick structures remains strong in South Australia</p>		
Pathways	Students may be able to gain apprenticeships in bricklaying, stonemasonry, solid plastering or tiling		
Entry Requirements	Students must have previously completed Certificate I or Certificate II in construction.		
Other Requirements	<p>Regular attendance in class and ability to complete work on time is essential. Students must be prepared to complete work at home if required. Students are required to wear appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), including steel cap shoes or boots</p>
